For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in this undertaking prevents the Defendant from removing felled timber as at 10 November 2020 in any of the above coupes, or prevents the Defendant from felling trees or parts of trees for the creation or maintenance of any road or in order to address a risk to human safety.

THE COURT ORDERS BY CONSENT THAT:

- 1. On or before 23 November 2020, the Defendant file and serve a Defence.
- 2. On or before 23 November 2020 the Defendant provide the Plaintiff with a draft proposed statement of agreed facts and issues in dispute.
- 3. On or before 30 November 2020, the Plaintiff file and serve a Reply (if any).
- 4. Within 7 days of receiving the draft proposed statement of agreed facts and issues, the Plaintiff provide the Defendant with its comments on the draft statement of agreed facts and issues in dispute.
- 5. Within 3 days after receiving the Plaintiff's comments, the Defendant, after conferral and agreement with the Plaintiff, file and serve a statement of agreed facts and issues in dispute.
- 6. Within 3 days after the Plaintiff provides its comments in accordance with order 5, the parties file any further evidence upon which they intend to rely at trial.
- 7. On or before 3 December 2020, the parties file and serve a written outline of submissions.
- 8. On or before 4 December 2020, the Defendant, after conferral and agreement with the Plaintiff, will provide to the Associate to the trial Judge:

- a. an electronic copy of the court book;
- b. a combined list of authorities; and
- c. an electronic copy of the authorities upon which the parties intend to rely.
- 9. On or before 10am on 8 December 2020, the parties file and serve any written submissions in reply.
- 10. The matter be listed for hearing on 9 December 2020 on an estimate of 1-2 days.
- 11. Liberty to apply.
- 12. Costs reserved.


